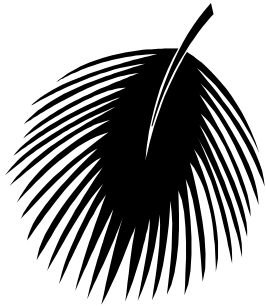


Timucua Plant Use Activity

PART A: Look at the pictures below. Use the descriptions to decide how Timucua people used each kind of plant. Then write each plant's name by its description. There are hints in the descriptions AND in the number of letters in each word!

| 1) _ _ _ _ | The Timucua used the large leaves to make roofs. |
| 2) _ _ _ _ _ _ | The Timucua used the inner bark from this tree's stems to make medicine for headaches. |
| 3) _ _ _ _ _ | The Timucua used the fruits to make a lemony tea. |
| 4) _ _ _ _ _ _ _ | The Timucua ate the nuts (seeds) from this tree and used its branches (stems) to make bows. |
| 5) _ _ _ _ _ _ _ | The Timucua ate these flower spikes like corn on the cob. |
| 6) _ _ _ _ _ _ | The Timucua ate the root of this wildflower. |
