Coloring Instructions: Color belly, underside of tail, chest, chin, and cheeks white. Add black spots on the bobcat's legs, chest, and the tip of its tail. The bobcat's nose and the insides of its ears should be pink. Color the rest of the bobcat light brown.

Interesting Fact: Bobcats got their name from their short tails. "Bobbed" means short. When they are babies, they have black spots all over their bodies, but as they age, the spots fade everywhere except their legs.
