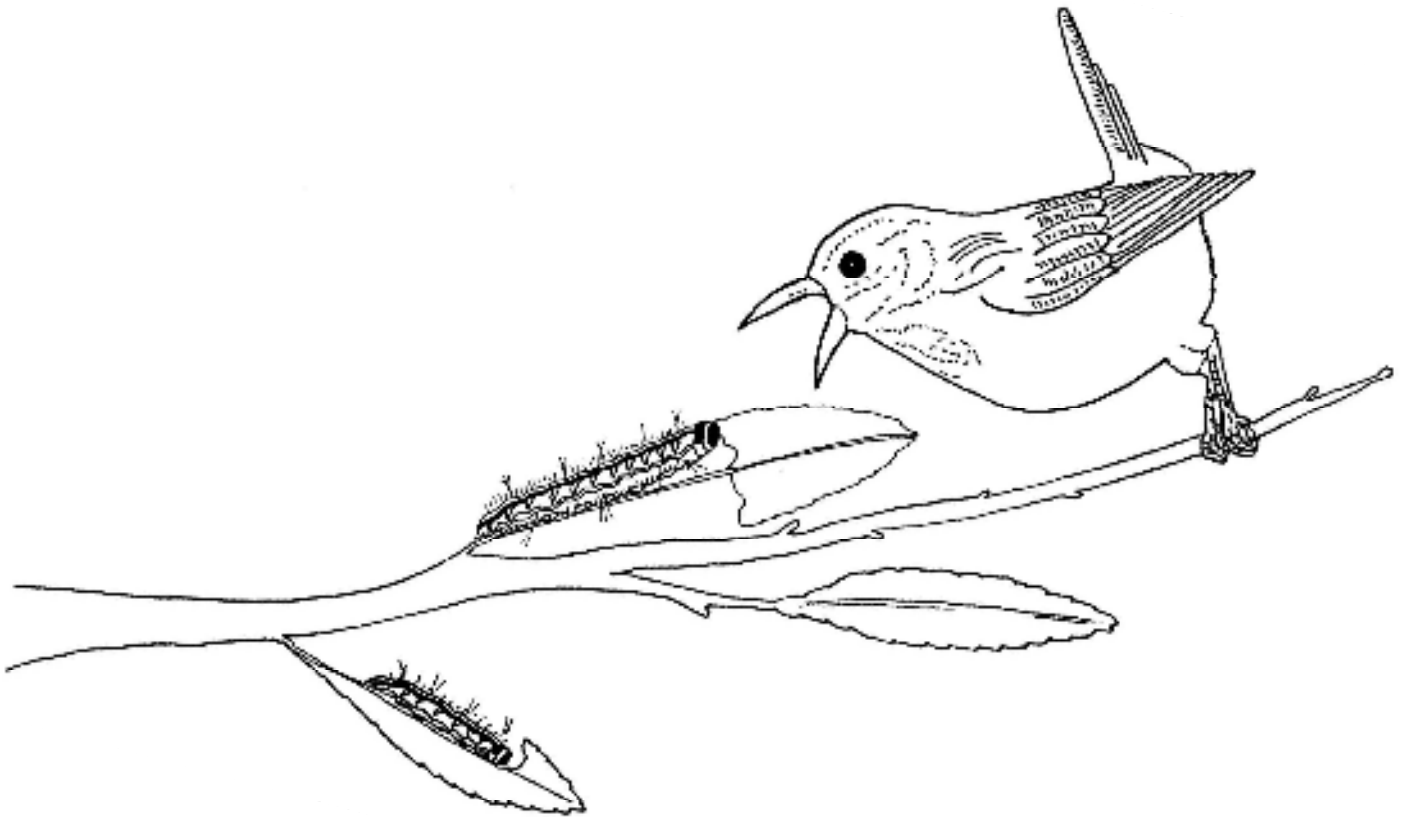


# Carolina Wren



**Coloring Instructions:** Color the tent caterpillars blue and orange. The wren's beak should be yellow, with the very tip black. Color a thin yellow stripe starting at the top of the wren's beak, going over its eye, and stopping at its neck. Its chin and the area under its tail should be white. Its legs and feet should be pink. Color its belly light brown. Color the rest of the wren rusty brown, including the top of its head.

**Interesting Fact:** The Carolina Wren will eat berries, lizards, and birdseed, but it is primarily a bug eater. It eats millipedes, grasshoppers, cockroaches, moths, spiders, and of course, caterpillars. A Carolina wren usually sticks its tail straight up like the one in the picture.
