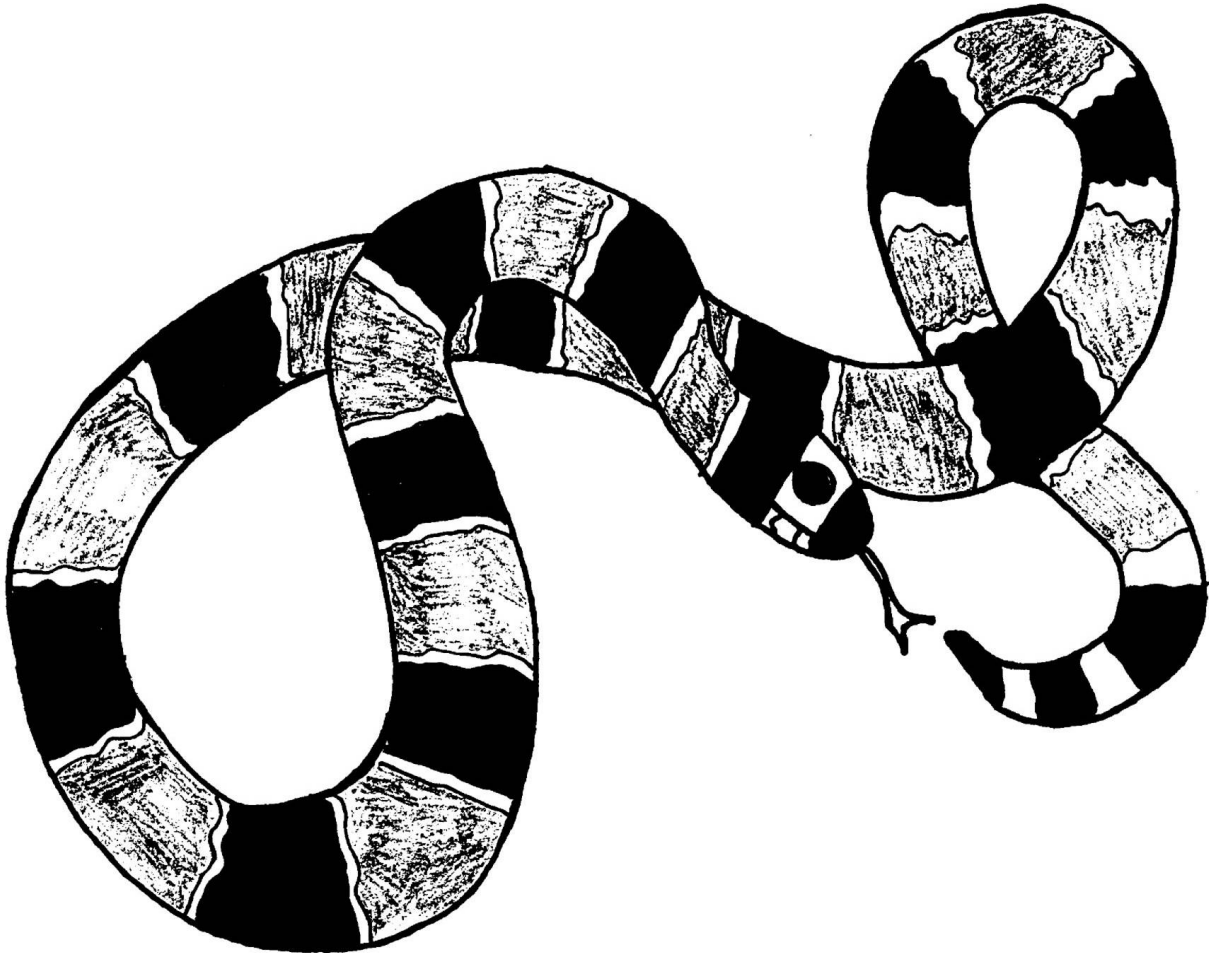


# Coral Snake



**Coloring Instructions** - Color the eye stripe yellow. After that, color each thin stripe yellow and each wide grayish stripe bright red.

**Interesting Fact:** Several non-venomous snakes look like venomous coral snakes, including milk snakes and scarlet king snakes. These other snakes benefit from looking like the coral snake because animals think they are venomous and leave them alone. The rhyme “red and yellow kills a fellow; red and black is safe for Jack” reminds us that on a coral snake, the red and yellow bands touch. On the other snakes, only the red and black bands touch. The safest thing to do is stay at least 5 steps away from any snake. If you’re close enough to check the colors, you’re too close!
