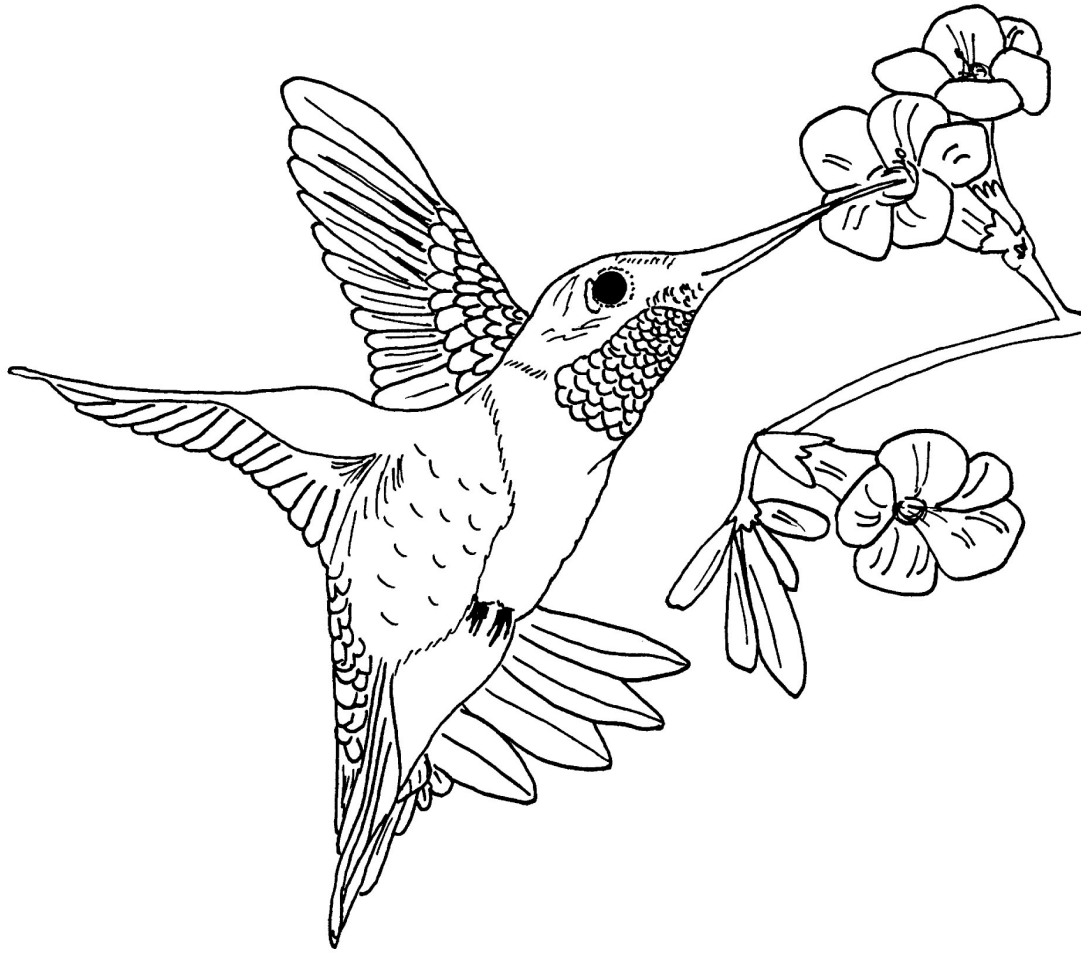


# Ruby-throated Hummingbird



**Coloring Instructions:** Color the flowers red. The hummingbird's belly and chest should be white. The tail, sides, and wings should be green. The ends of its wings should be very dark green, almost black. The top of its head should be green too. If this is a male hummingbird, color the throat feathers red. If this is a female hummingbird, leave the throat feathers white.

**Interesting Fact:** Ruby-throated hummingbirds prefer to get nectar from red flowers, so hummingbird feeders are usually made out of red plastic, to get this tiny bird's attention. Hummingbirds will protect their food territory (either flowers or feeders) by chasing away other birds and bees that fly too close.
