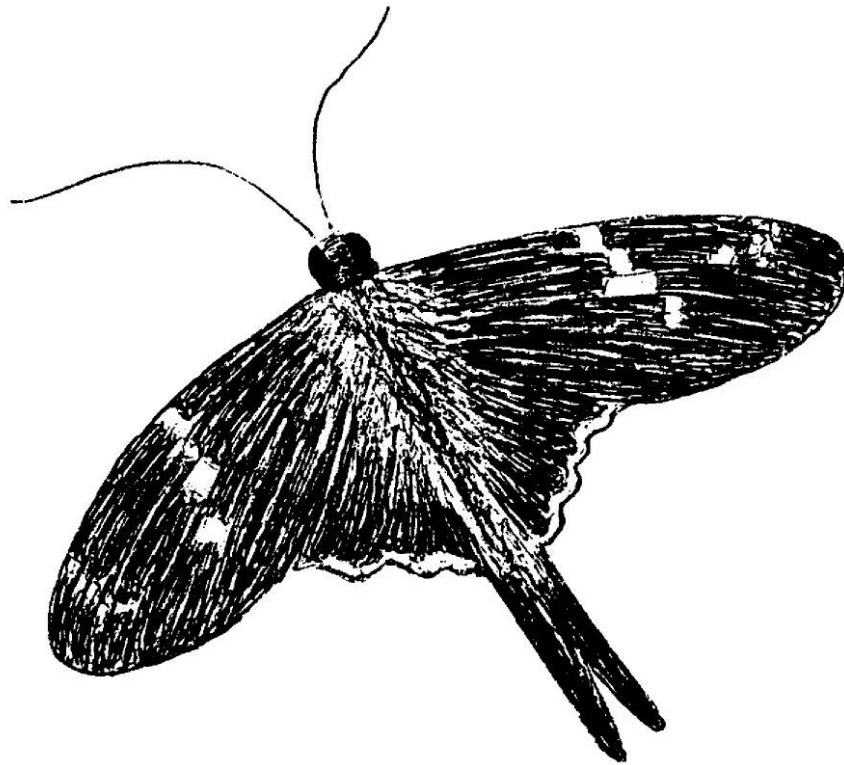


Long-tailed Skipper



Coloring Instructions: Color the markings on its wings light green. The bottom edges of its wings should be white. The middle of its back and its head should be bright blue. Its tail and the rest of its wings should be brownish-gray.

Interesting Fact: Skippers are neither butterflies nor moths. They make up their own special group. Baby Long-tailed Skippers have a unique way of hiding from predators. These caterpillars find a bean leaf to roll around themselves. This way, they can eat the rolled leaf while hiding inside. Sometimes this caterpillar is called a “bean-leaf roller.”
