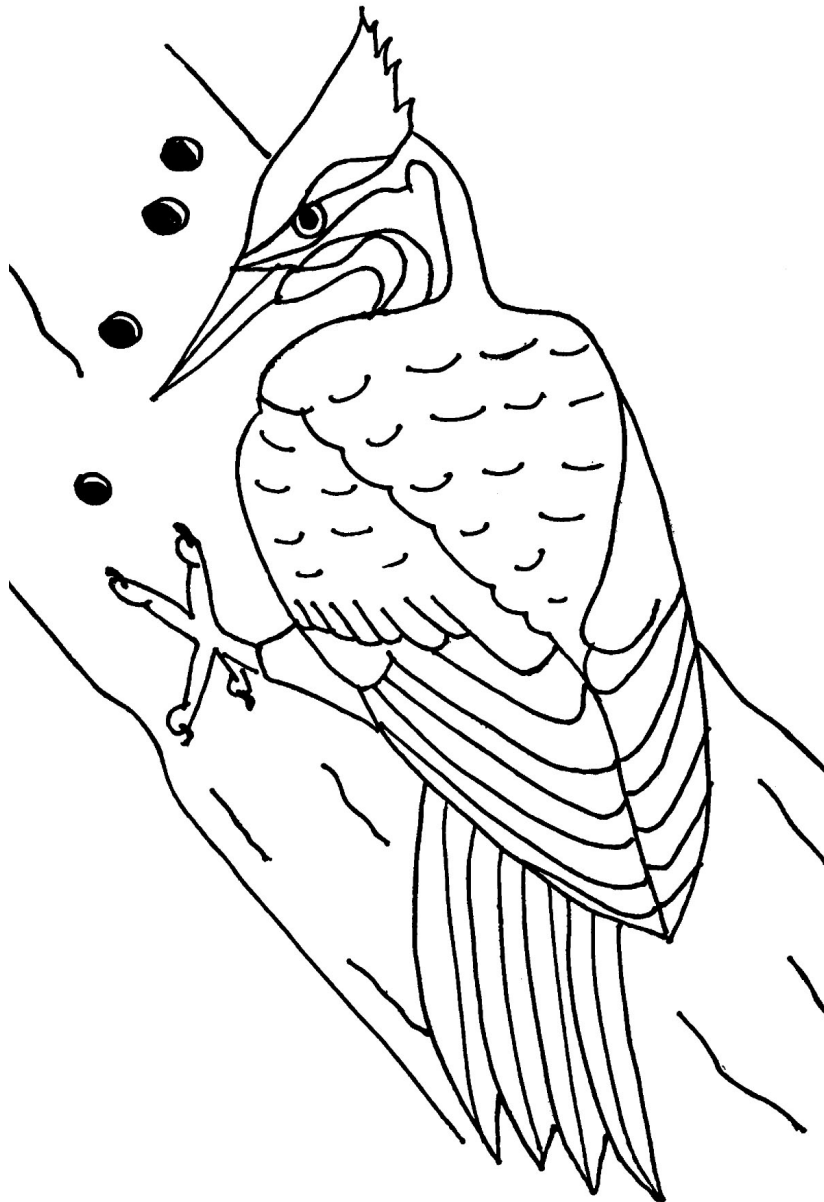


Pileated Woodpecker



Coloring Instructions:

Color the top of the head red. The stripe below that is white. The eye stripe and the back of the neck are black. The stripe under the eye is white. The cheek patch is red. The chin is white. The strip to the right of the cheek patch should be black. Color the beak and feet gray. The rest of the bird should be black. Don't forget to color the tree brown!

Interesting Fact: Pileated woodpeckers use the same nesting tree over and over again, but peck out a new nesting hole each year. They will defend their babies against anything, even snakes. Pileated woodpeckers are the largest common woodpecker, measuring 19" tall with wings that stretch 30" wide!
