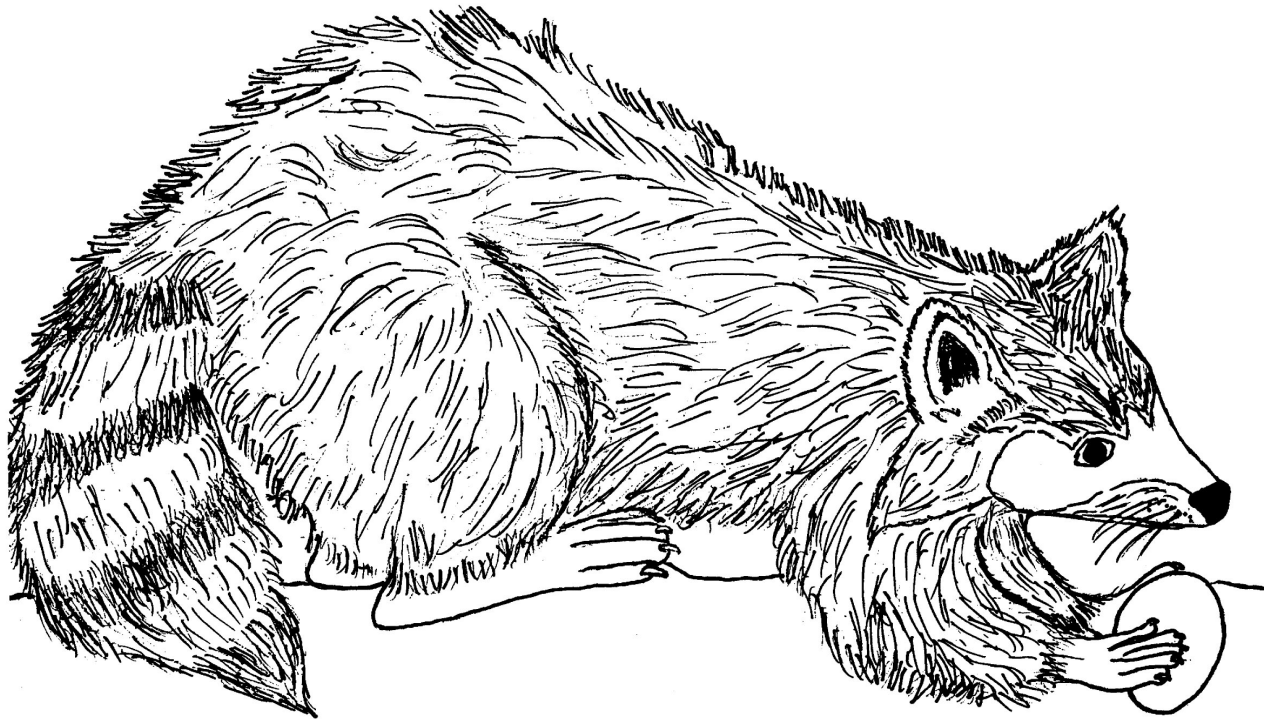


Raccoon



Coloring Instructions: Color the raccoon's cheeks light gray. The mask around the raccoon's eyes should be black. Color light gray on the raccoon's cheeks and just above its eyes. The raccoon's feet should be dark gray. The rest of the raccoon should be light grayish-brown.

Interesting Fact: Raccoons are omnivores (OM-ni-vor-z), eating both meat and plants. In fact, raccoons can and will eat almost anything, including berries, grasshoppers, crabs, dog food, road kills, and garbage. Raccoons often choose to live near people so they can find easy trash meals. These raccoons can become very aggressive, even stealing sandwiches from picnickers. Some raccoons carry a disease called rabies, which can be transmitted to people through a bite. If bitten by a raccoon, a person must get rabies shots so they won't catch this deadly disease.
