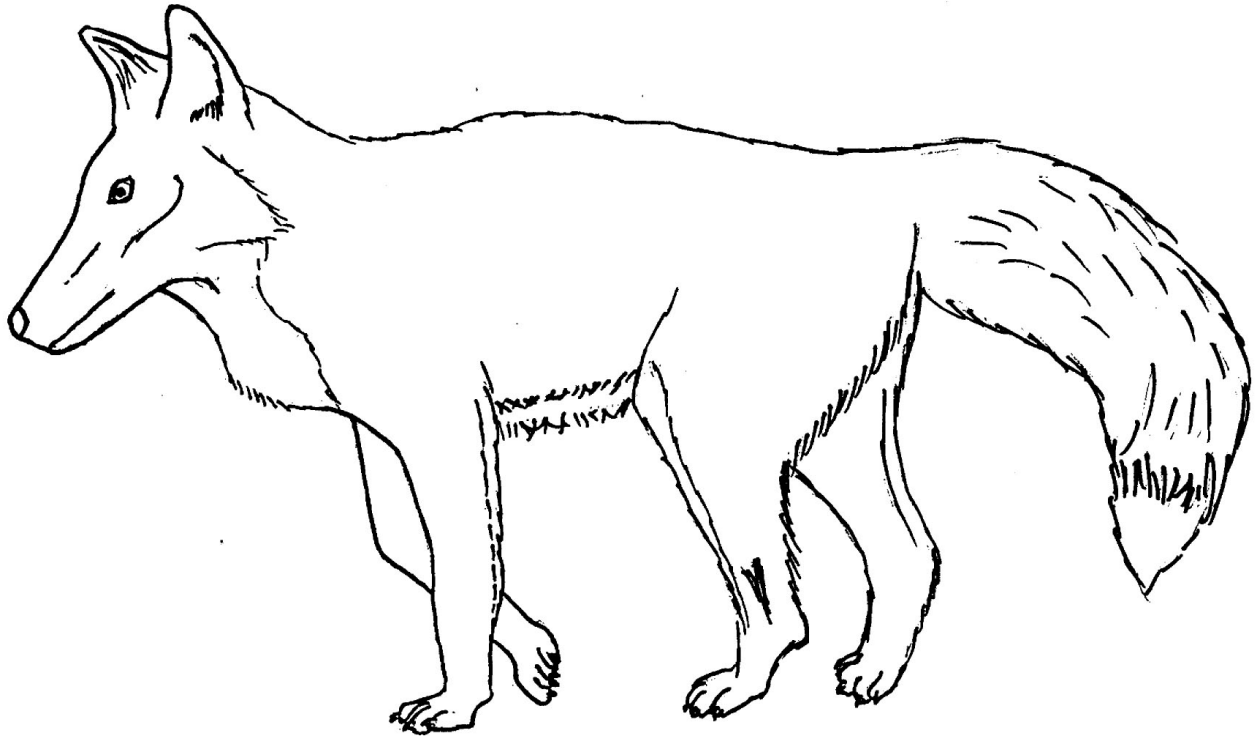


Red Fox



Coloring Instructions: The following parts of the fox should be white: the tip of its tail, its belly, its cheeks and chin, its chest, and the insides of its ears. Color its nose, feet, lower legs, and the backs of its ears black. The rest of the fox should be an orange-brown color. Some red foxes are grayish. You can color gray over the orange-brown if your fox is in its gray phase.

Interesting Fact: Red foxes can come in many different color phases, including orangish-brown, all black, silvery-gray, and a combination which has orangish brown fur with black shoulders. You can always tell if it's a red fox because only red foxes have white tail tips.
