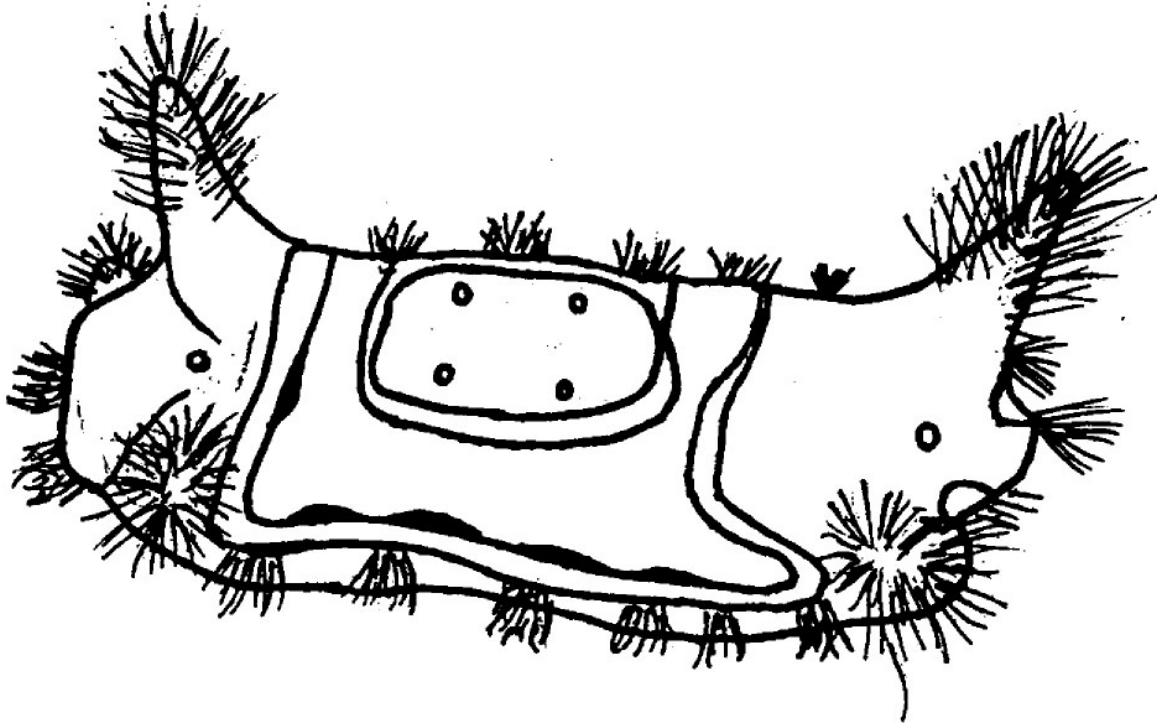


# Saddleback Caterpillar



**Coloring Instructions** – Each of the small spots should be white. Color the oval in the middle of the caterpillar’s back brown. The circle around this should be white. Color the area around this bright green. The outline around this area is white. The spines are light brown. The rest of the caterpillar is dark brown.

**Interesting Fact:** This caterpillar is only an inch long, but it has a painful sting. It is called a saddleback because of the saddle-like brown and white markings on its back. After it pupates, this caterpillar becomes a small, brown moth.
