

Yellow-bellied Sapsucker

Coloring Instructions: Color its forehead and chin red. Color its belly a very light yellow. Color its beak a light blue. The rest of the bird is white.

Interesting Fact: Yellow-bellied sapsuckers are less than 8" long. They always tap holes in straight lines. Sweet sap flows out of these holes to protect the wound in the tree. Insects are attracted to this sweet sap. When the insects fly up for a meal, the yellow-bellied sapsucker eats up the insects for protein, then sucks up the sap for a sugary treat.
