

Yellow-shafted Flicker



Coloring Instructions: Color the stripe behind its eye red and the top of its head gray. Its chin should be light brown. Its belly and sides should be light yellow, except for the area above its tail, which is white. The top rim on the front wing should be white. The rest of the front wing should be very bright yellow. The back wing (which shows the top of the wing) should be dark brown.

Interesting Fact: Flickers are about 10 inches long. In the eastern US, we have yellow-shafted flicker. In the western US, they have red-shafted flickers (with red wings instead of yellow-wings).
